- NO MATTRESSES, BOX SPRINGS, FURNITURE, TV's or MICROWAVE OVENS
- NO MOTOR OIL
- TAKE ABOVE ITEMS AND ANY OTHER ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT SITES TO THE LINCOLN COUNTY LANDFILL

- **MOTOR OIL** Take to Lincoln County Landfill
- **TIRES** Automobile and truck tires accepted for a fee.

MUST HAVE DISPOSAL STICKER TO USE WASTE & RECYCLING SITES

MANDATORY RECYCLING RULES

These items must be SEPARATED from garbage.

MIXED PAPER/CARDBOARD BIN

(All cardboard must be flattened.)

Customers can put any of the following recyclable paper into the mixed paper/cardboard bin, including:

corrugated cardboard
(no waxed or plastic coatings)

tag board (cereal/pop boxes)

newspapers (including glossies)

any paper junk mail

magazines & catalogues

telephone books

hard & soft cover books

all paper bags

computer paper

notebook paper

tag board file folders

blue prints/plans

pamphlets

paper envelopes

legal or ledger size paper

construction paper

basically any paper with writing that does not have food, oil or other contaminants on!

All paper should be clean and dry.

No plastic bags, binders, covers, or overheads.

Only shredded paper will be accepted in plastic clear plastic bags!

MIXED CONTAINERS BIN

Customers can put any of the following containers in the container bin, including:

plastic bottles # 1-7

tin cans

aluminum cans

glass bottles & jars

All containers must be rinsed out.

Lids and caps must be removed from bottles & jars.

NO plastic bags, tinfoil, window glass or ceramic mugs/cups.
