- 1) Call to Order: Chairperson Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Present were Supervisors Joan Hilgendorf, Bill Jelinek and Robert Eisenman.

- 6) Clerk's Business

- 8) Resolution 2016-3 for revisions to the Lincoln County Zoning Ordinance related to accessory structures was held over until the September meeting for clarification.
- Resolution 2016-4 for Road Aides Increase per WTA M/M Koth/Hilgendorf to approve and sign. Motion Passed 4-0
- 10) Debbie Smith talked about the speed limit and no ATV signs posted on Sunset Point Road. Kevin will be talking with Byron Lange about changing the speed limit on Sunset Point Road to 45MPH. Debbie Smith did pay the \$20.00 for the ATV sign to be posted. Once that sign comes in the road crew will post it opening that road to ATV/UTV traffic.
- 11) Clarann Stocker discussed the rules and regulations to having dogs in the Town of Bradley. It was stated that the Town follows the same rules as the Lincoln County leash law.  - D. Tom Leck (Roadhouse LLC)/Lester Schmidt will request a minor subdivision of the property north of the Tomahawk Race Track. This will be discussed at the next Plan Commission meeting on August 22, 2016 at 6:30pm.
