

Town Board Meeting  
July 9, 2018 5:30pm  
Bradley Town Hall

Chairperson Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Supervisors Robert Eisenman & Bill Jelinek were present. Absent was Supervisor Joan Hilgendorf.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund-\$107,908.05 Equipment Fund - \$159,684.71; General Savings Account - \$125,536.45; Checking Account - \$110,970.58; Cemetery Fund - \$117,887.32; Re-Evaluation - \$30,000.00 and Greenwood Cemetery CD - \$12,399.74.

Harold Bohne with the Muskellunge Lake Association is making a request to have the boat landing looked at off of Cottage Road. The apron on the end has sunk and made launching a boat difficult. Contact will have to be made with the DNR to see what we are allowed to do for repairs.

Larry Rydberg with the Nokomis ATV Club presented the board with information in regards to opening an ATV trail that would run from County L to Essex Road. It was decided the board would need more information from the club before this request could be addressed.

Plan Commission had nothing to report their next meeting will be held on July 23, 2018 at 6:30pm.

Road Report: The town had received a request from residents on Kings Road about getting the speed reduced from 35 mph to 25 mph. After many failed tries with the DOT to address this issue it was decided to look at putting shoulders on the road so walkers/bikers would have a safe place to get off the road. Trees have now been marked on the road right-of-way to be removed. If this is a project the town proceeds with the cutting would take place over the winter of 2018/2019, grubbing done in the spring of 2019, shoulders installed in 2019 and blacktopping possibly taking place in 2020. Residents will be notified once a final decision is reached. It was decided to pass on the warranty for the grader as it did not seem cost effective. All roads are now blacktopped and shoulder clean-up will start. The Bradley road crew will do what they can before we hire the county.

Waste/Recycling Report: Had an over flow of garbage one weekend. It was addressed with Eagle Waste about needing pick-up so we are always ready to go on opening mornings. This is a learning experience for everyone involved and hopefully this issue has been resolved. The guys out there have been extremely busy over the holiday week and seem to be keeping up.

Cemetery Report: A new pump was installed at the cemetery. Supervisor Jelinek received a proposal from ACE Landscaping for a scattering garden in the amount of \$8,350.00, at this point this is just off of a rough draft. The pond at the cemetery has been shut down due to a leak. Once they find/fix the leak it will be started up again.

Parks & Beach Report: Supervisor Eisenman is still working with the county and DNR regarding Crystal Beach and permits. It was decided the entire Board will need to meet at Theisen Park to walk it and decide how to proceed with it. Supervisor Hilgendorf had submitted a letter that was read at the meeting regarding her concerns with the parks & beach.

Building & Grounds: None

Other business not requiring board action: Tripoli Propane will remove the tanks at both dump sites. OJ Services will be contacted to clean out the port-a-potties at both dump sites and then they will be locked.

As there was no other business the meeting was adjourned at 6:48PM.
