

Town Board Meeting  
August 8, 2005 5:30 P.M.

Chairman Jack Huston called the meeting to order. Present were Supervisors Elsie Bartz, Bill Jelinek and Kevin Koth.

The vouchers had been signed.

Plan Commission Chair Diana Smith reported that the commission recommends approval of the request to change two parcels (3406-153-9989 and 3406-154-9997) in Section 15, T. 34N. – R. 6E, off Stelling Road from Rural Lands 4 to Rural Residential 3 on the Plan Map for Byron and Janet Lange and the request to change a parcel (3406-153-9997) in Section 15, T. 34N.- R. 6E., off County Highway E from Rural Lands 4 to Rural Residential 3 on the Plan Map for Scott Lange.

She asked that the board consider sending a letter out to contractor shops in the town alerting them to the fact that the town supports allowing contractor shops as a conditionally permitted use within the new Planned Business District, but that the final decision will be made by County Board Supervisors.

She also asked permission for a member of the Town's Plan Commission to attend each meeting of the City of Tomahawk Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee at  $\frac{1}{4}$  per diem.

Doug Sheel appeared to ask the board to take into consideration, when doing Selmer Road to move the road over approximately 25 feet to where it should be. Supervisor Bartz suggested that the board go out to look at the road.
