

Special Town Board Meeting
Thursday, February 24, 2005
Bradley Town Hall
8:30 a.m.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jack Huston. Supervisors Elsie Bartz and Bill Jelinek were present. Supervisor Kevin Koth was absent. Also, present were Byron Lange and Bob Eisenman.

The Town received one bid for clearing and removing brush on Dereg and Selmer Roads. M/S Bartz-Jelinek to accept the bid from Arnott Trucking, Inc., for a total of \$17,000.00 - \$7,000 for clearing trees and removing brush on Dereg Road and \$10,000 for the same on Selmer Road. All agreed. Byron will notify Arnott's that their bid was accepted.

Chairman Huston contacted Mark Jenko, State Inspector of campgrounds about camping at Kahle Park. The Town can get a 7-day permit. The price of the permit will be determined by the number of sites. Fresh water and toilet facilities are required. The Town will check with the insurance company to see if the Town is covered. In addition, Mr. Jenko would be willing to come out to the Park and measure and determine how many sites would be allowed. This will be placed on the March agenda for discussion and possible action.
