

Town Board Meeting

Chairman Jack Huston called the meeting to order. Present were Supervisors Bill Jelinek, Kevin Koth and Joan Hilgendorf.

M/M Hilgendorf/Huston to adjourn into closed session pursuant to SS 19.85(c) (considering employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee).
Passed 4-0

Discussion was held.

M/M Hilgendorf/Huston to return to open session to report findings.

The probation period for road supervisor Brian Gruhlke and road worker Adam Scherer is over. The board feels that both are doing a good job. It was noted by the board that Brian is doing a good job on the paperwork and is keeping very detailed records. Also being year end that there is a lot of paperwork.
