February 13, 2012 5:30 P.M.

Chairman Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Present were Supervisors Joan Hilgendorf, Robert Eisenman and Bill Jelinek.

The Treasurer's report is as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund - \$59,902.67 Equipment Fund - \$270,887.49 General Savings Account - \$2,475,334.28 Checking Account - \$103,227.25, Cemetery Fund - \$19,755.44, Playground Fund – \$6,900.00. Greenwood Cemetery CD's - \$100,000.00 and \$12,170.83. Tax money collected - \$2,481,420.78

M/M Hilgendorf/Eisenman to approve the minutes from the January 9th meeting. Motion passed 4-0

M/M Hilgendorf/Jelinek to approve payment of vouchers #4515 through #4568. Motion passed 4-0.

There were no license applications or correspondence.

M/M Hilgendorf/Koth to send the Oneida County Board a letter of support for the creation of a Nokomis/Bridge Lake District. Motion passed 4-0

No action was taken of the request from the Tomahawk Area Chamber of Commerce to consider implementing a 4% room tax.

M/M Hilgendorf/Jelinek to adopt Boiler MACT Resolution 2012-1. Motion passed 4-0

Road Consultant Byron Lange reported that the trees have been cut on Peaceful Valley Road. The pulverizing proposals should be out by the beginning of March. The road workers will be attending the Work Zone and Flaggers Safety class.

The board will be looking at maintenance options for the beach, hall, and parks.

Plan Commission Chair Harry Gladwin reported that there had not been a January meeting. Also, that he and Bill Jelinek had attended a meeting at Lincoln County Zoning to discuss the information needed to complete the Land Use Plan. The next meeting will be February 27th at 6:30 P.M.
