

Town Board Meeting
June 11, 2012 5:30 P.M.
Bradley Town Hall

Chairman Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Present were Supervisors Joan Hilgendorf, and Robert Eisenman. Bill Jelinek was excused.

The Treasurer's report is as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund - \$59,976.38 Equipment Fund - \$150,530.95 General Savings Account - \$75,351.02 Checking Account - \$271,559.95, Cemetery Fund - \$19,755.44, Playground Fund – \$6,900.00. Greenwood Cemetery CD's - \$100,000.00 and Greenwood Beautification – \$12,170.83.

M/M Hilgendorf/Eisenman to approve the minutes of the public hearing and the board minutes from May 14th. Motion passed 3-0.

M/M Hilgendorf/Koth to approve payment of vouchers #4744 through #4803. Motion passed 3-0.

M/M Hilgendorf/Koth to approve the following licenses:

"Class B" Beer and Liquor: A&J Sports Bar & Grill, Besse's On Clear Lake, Road Lake Pub & Grill, Billy Bob's Sports Bar & Grill, Edgewater Country Club, Cockatiel's Bar & Grill, Four Corners Tap, Holly's, Inshalla Country Club, Happy Quacker, End Zone, The Good Times, Norma's 2, Oaks Pub, Silver Birch Supper Club, T's Roadhouse and Tomahawk Race Way.

M/M Hilgendorf/Eisenman to approve the fireworks permits for Ken Kenworthy W5220 Terrace View Road July 3-4, Bob Weaver N10130 Echo Valley Road July 4-5, Bill Steinhafel 6976 Branch Road July 4-5, Harold Schrage W6815 Peaceful Valley Road July 7-8 and Aug 4, and John Swarmer N10503 Tannery Road July 3-4. Motion passed 3-0.

M/M Hilgendorf/Eisenman to reimburse Chairman Koth for mileage and room for the WTA annual county unit meeting to be held in Stevens Point July 27th & 28th. Motion passed 3-0.

Following discussion, it was decided to approve requested town road(s) for ATV/UTV travel on a quarterly basis, starting with July's Monthly Board meeting.

M/M Koth/Hilgendorf to have ATV clubs sign the town roads that lead to a there trail system. Signs and posts for requested town roads that do not lead to a trail systems, will be paid for by those requesting a road(s) to be opened. Motion passed 3-0.

M/M Koth/Hilgendorf to approve opening Peaceful Valley Road and Mohawksin Road to ATV/UTV travel. Motion passed 3-0.

M/M Koth /Hilgendorf to approve opening Geoffroy, Vacation Lane, Park Lane, River Oaks, Thomas, and Stelling roads to ATV/UTV travel. Motion passed 3-0.

Tannery Road, Red Pine, Rice, Kablitz and Wimmer roads will be placed on the July's Board meeting agenda.

Byron Lange reported that all the blacktopping has been finished. He is looking into the purchase of gravel. He will be contacting the adjoining property owner by Bay Mill boat landing about extending the parking area.

Brian Gruhlke will look into window screens for Kahle Park.

Koth is going to contact Veolia about the actual weights for our recyclables.
