February 11, 2013 5:30 P.M.

Chairman Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Supervisors Robert Eisenman, Bill Jelinek and Joan Hilgendorf were present.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund - \$69,569.04; Equipment Fund - \$189,883.37; General Savings Account - \$2,432,815.57; Checking Account - \$123,481.43; Cemetery Fund - \$19,436.01; Playground Fund - \$15,691.59; Greenwood Cemetery - \$100,000.00 CD, and Greenwood Beautification - \$12,339.48 . Tax money collected - \$2,432,815.57.

Hilgendorf/Jelinek to approve the minutes for the on January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2013 meeting with a change made. Motion passed 4-0.

Hilgendorf/Eisenman to approve payment of vouchers #1146 through #1320. Motion passed 4-0.

Robert Russell candidate for Lincoln County Court Judge appeared and spoke on his background and what the office entails.

There were no license applications or correspondence.

Brian Gruhlke said that they are waiting for the information on the road width for Nibler Road.

Eisenman/Koth to approve the Greenwood Cemetery Ordinance 2-13. Motion passed 4-0.

The new Greenwood Cemetery rules were accepted by the Board.

Jelinek will look at prices for informational cases for the Greenwood Cemetery.

Hilgendorf/Jelinek to approve the Easement and Restrictive Agreement between the city and the town on property off of Green Box Road. Motion passed 4-0.

Koth will be contacting the Tomahawk School District after the Town's Attorney Mark Alberg reviews the expired lease between the Town and the School District for Kahle Park.

Hilgendorf/Eisenman to approve the revised Town of Bradley's Land Use Plan with the inclusion of the general business zoning. Motion passed 4-0. A public hearing will be held at 5:00 March 11<sup>th</sup> prior to the regular board meeting.
