

Town of Bradley Board Meeting  
Monday, June 10, 2013  
5:30 p.m.  
Bradley Town Hall

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Kevin Koth. Supervisors Robert Eisenman, Bill Jelinek, and Joan Hilgendorf were present. Clerk Ann Eckman was absent.

Treasurer's Report: Cemetery Fund - \$19,436.06; Playground Equipment Fund - \$15,691.59; Building and Office Equipment Fund - \$69,593.64; Equipment Fund - \$189,957.25; General Savings Account - \$223,700.37; Checking Account - \$109,983.84; Greenwood Cemetery CD - \$100,000.00; Greenwood Beautification - \$12,339.48.

Hilgendorf/Eisenman to approve the minutes from the May 13<sup>th</sup> monthly Board meeting. Motion passed 4-0.

Hilgendorf/Koth to approve payment of vouchers #1485-1518. Motion passed 4-0.

The Town received a thank you from the Chuck Crass family.

The road mowing will be split between Chuck Theiler – will do Bradley South and WeSuc Septic Services and Excavating will do Bradley North. Roads with dense brush that can't be reached by mowers will be done by County.

Hilgendorf/Eisenman to approve the following fireworks permits: Harold Schrage – July 3 or 4 and August 1 or 2; Bob Wulf – July 3 & 4; Elaine Steinhafel – July 4 & 5; Pamela Albrecht – July 2 or 3; Steve Brummond – June 29; Bob Weaver – July 5 & 6. Motion passed 4-0.

Milky, Tomahawk River and Krebs Roads will be pulverized yet this week and clean up ditch on Tomahawk River Road to prepare for paving. Another load of gravel will be placed on Red Pine Road by culvert. Grader will be hauled to Fabco for maintenance repairs when not needed. Board will not advertise for crack filling bids this year – not enough need; will be taken care of by road crew and Lincoln County.

Koth/Jelinek to award grubbing bid for Nibler Road to Arnott Trucking - \$5,500.00. Motion passed 4-0.

Jelinek reported that the leak in the water line at Greenwood Cemetery has been repaired. He has also been in contact with local Boy Scout Master about cleaning up the scattering ground area by the local scouts.

Eisenman will contact Hetzel's about an automatic shut off for the water at Theisen Park – water has been left running.

No action was taken on the Kahle Park agreement - Hilgendorf will contact the school district about buying Gilbert School. This will be placed on the July agenda.

Plan Commission – no recommendations. Lincoln County approved the conditional use request for County Materials with two modifications: Regulations contained in 17.3.08 (10) of Lincoln County ordinances area made a part of the conditions of approval and the conditional use will be reviewed by County and Town in 10 years with option to renew another 10 years being contingent on compliance with the conditions of original permit. Reclamation will be ongoing in accordance with page 18, section 4.2 of County Material's proposed reclamation plan "loads on all truck must be covered if so equipped and the public road will be inspected daily by County Materials during times of pit use and any obstructions be remedied. Next plan commission meeting is June 24 at 6:30 p.m.

Hilgendorf/Jelinek to adjourn. Motion passed 4-0.
