The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund-\$0.00 Equipment Fund - \$253,690.97; General Savings Account - \$22,877.41; Checking Account - \$149,669.63; Cemetery Fund - \$17,686.06; Playground Fund - \$14,747.59; Greenwood Cemetery - \$100,000.00 CD and Cemetery Beautification Fund - \$12,300.90
