

Town Board Meeting
July 8, 2014
Immediately following the Public Hearing

Chairperson Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Supervisors Robert Eisenman, Bill Jelinek and Joan Hilgendorf were present.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund - \$84,978.63
Equipment Fund - \$221,906.62; General Savings Account - \$62,866.52; Checking Account - \$34,349.64;
Cemetery Fund - \$17,686.06; Playground Fund - \$15,691.59; Greenwood Cemetery - \$100,000.00 CD
and Cemetery Beautification Fund - \$12,300.90

M/M Hilgendorf/Koth to approve the minutes from the June 9, 2014 board meeting with the correction of adding the Cemetery Beautification amount of \$12,300.90 to the Treasurer's report. Motion passed 4-0.
M/M Hilgendorf/Koth to approve the vouchers # 2237 through #2294 with the exception of #2278. Motion passed 4-0.

M/M Jelinek/Koth to recommend approval of the rezone request by Brian McCarthy (owner) and Joe Henrich of Concrete Investments (buyer) to rezone a property located at N12014 County Road L from RR1 to Crossroads Mixed Use. Motion passed 4-0

Caroline Lemke announced her retirement at the close of the 2014 assessment year after 35 years as the town's assessor.

M/M Koth/Eisenman to accept the proposal from Decker Lumber & Supply to build the additional garage. Motion passed 4-0. The board decided not to do the entryway to the existing hall at this time.
