

Town Board Meeting  
October 9, 2017 5:30 P.M.  
Bradley Town Hall

- 1) Call to Order: Supervisor Joan Hilgendorf called the meeting to order at 5:30pm. Present were Supervisors Bill Jelinek and Robert Eisenman. Absent was Chairman Kevin Koth.
- 2) Pledge of Allegiance
- 3) Public Comment: None
- 4) Treasurers Report: Building & Office Equipment Fund-\$107,816.88; Equipment Fund - \$132,313.51; General Savings Account - \$9,723.49; Checking Account - \$194,532.98; Cemetery Fund - \$117,887.32; Re-Evaluation \$15,000.00; and Greenwood Cemetery Beautification Fund - \$12,381.01.
- 5) Minutes of Previous Meeting: September 11, 2017 meeting Eisenman/Jelinek motion to approve. Motion passed 3-0
- 6) Clerk's Business
  - A. Payment of vouchers #4644 through #4667: Jelinek/Eisenman motion to approve. Motion passed 3-0.
  - B. Operators Licenses request for Christine Bacholl & Tiffany Calhoun: Eisenman/Jelinek motion to approve. Motion passed 3-0
- 7) Correspondence - None
- 8) Quick Claim Deed for William & Kerrie Butenschoen for property located at N11350 Dereg Road E, Tomahawk will appear on next month's agenda once the Town receives the quick claim deed from Oneida Title for signing.
- 9) Request by Lesley Likwarz to have the speed limit on Kings Road reduced was discussed. It will appear on the November agenda once more information can be compiled and the Town can follow up on the speed sign that is supposed to be posted in that area.
- 10) Resolution of Special Charges regarding fire calls was presented. Eisenman/Jelinek motion to approve putting the fire calls on tax bills as a special assessment. Motion passed 3-0.
- 11) The use of weed killers around signs/posts was discussed. The information was presented to the board by Diana Smith regarding the ingredients in the weed killer and its safety. Signs are sprayed for safety purposes to keep them visible. The Town will consider other options in controlling the weeds.
- 12) Waste and Recycling Contract/Proposals were presented. The town only received the one proposal from Advance Disposal with a significant increase in services. This will be discussed at a special meeting to be held later in October when all board members are present.
- 13) Pan Commission made the recommendation for a conditional use request by Brad Koenig to build a small cottage on a 2.5 acre parcel, #04.063506.002.004.02.00 on Serenity Island, Rice River Flowage. The next plan commission meeting is scheduled for October 23, 2017 at 6:30pm.
- 14) Eisenman/Jelinek motion to approve Conditional Use request by Brad Koenig for small cottage on Serenity Island. Motion passed 3-0.
- 15) Gravel crushing proposals were received from County Materials and American Asphalt. Hilgendorf/Eisenman made a motion to approve the proposal from County Materials in the amount of \$99,000.00 for 18,000 tons at \$5.50/ton. Motion passed 3-0.
- 16) Byron Lange gave the road report stating that the pacer program is entered and complete. Rocks Falls completed the mowing out on Tamarack and trees have been marked out there for cutting/trimming. Arnott will work with the Town on a per hour basis to do some shouldering clean-up on Wolf, Terrace View, Wurl and Klade Road.
- 17) Cemetery Report: Fall clean-up has been completed at the cemetery and winter decorations may go back out. The water has been turned off for the winter.

**18)** Parks & Beach Report: Gary Hilgendorf will look at fixing the door at Kahle Park before winter.

**20)** Any other business not requiring board action: Letters will be sent out to residents informing them that they cannot place debris in the road, for example leaves and snow.
