Construction:

Peaceful Valley Road – Looked over the road, bids to be opened at 10:00 a.m. in the 8th.

Bay Mill Road – first part of road will be looked at in 2009 when we do the blacktopping on Peaceful Valley Road.

Beach Road – will be determined what will be done following the bids on Peaceful Valley Road. Replace a couple culverts.

Wurl Road – tree cutting, needs deep shoulder clean up, placed on 6 year plan.

Cottage Road – continue working on plans to connect with Klade Road.

Center Avenue – trailer parked on road. **“No Parking” on both sides of road?**

Alber Road – gravel & put in new culvert.

Wadell Road – ditching beyond culvert to get water to run.

Alery Road – looked at where new gate has been set, it is okay.

Blum Road – add gravel.

Koth Road – pick up blacktop at beginning of road, have crushed for Town use.

Tamarack Lane – grade gravel, contact Rock Falls.

Maintenance:

Milky Road – shoulders, tree cutting

Kablitz Road – brushing

Rice Road – clean up turnaround at end of road

Wimmer Road – fix turnaround

High View Road – cut hill and widen

Nibler Road – fix dip in road

Clear Lake Road – mow back farther

Schlising Road – mow back farther

Willow Lane – needs gravel
Behling Road - culvert

Parks:

Theisen – clear out where we purchased property from corner to corner.
Kahle – go down to one tennis court. Replace blacktop on the court, and one half of the basketball court. Leave remaining old blacktop for parking. Will move the other basketball hoop to Theisen Park. The road crew will move fence.
