Chairman Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Supervisors Robert Eisenman, Bill Jelinek and Joan Hilgendorf were present.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund - \$69,575.09; Equipment Fund - \$189,901.53; General Savings Account - \$323,639.33; Checking Account - \$136,835.69; Cemetery Fund - \$19,436.06; Playground Fund - \$15,691.59; Greenwood Cemetery - \$100,000.00 CD, and Greenwood Beautification - \$12,339.48.

The clerk noted that she had received a copy of a resolution that was passed by the Town of Pine River and two from the Town of Birch, and an e-mail from Orrin Kohlberg concerning the proposed gravel pit on Crass Road.

Byron Lange reported that a search had been done by Lincoln County Abstract and that there we no mention of the width of Nibler Road so the road would be 66 feet according to State Statutes.

Signs for the cemetery were discussed. Justin Lemke will be contacted to see if he might be interested in giving the town a price to make them.

Bob and Phil Zipp were at the meeting for information on whether lots had been set aside in Block 27 for veteran's burials. It was decided to wait until spring to look at the area to see how many lots might be available.

There was nothing to report for building and grounds.
