

Town Board Meeting
April 15, 2014
Immediately following Annual Meeting
Bradley Town Hall

Chairperson Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Supervisors Robert Eisenman, Bill Jelinek and Joan Hilgendorf were present.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund - \$82,317.43
Equipment Fund - \$221,842.95; General Savings Account - \$162,831.41; Checking Account -
\$203,341.53; Cemetery Fund - \$17,686.06; Playground Fund - \$15,691.59; Greenwood Cemetery -
\$100,000.00 CD.

M/M Hilgendorf/Eisenman to approve the minutes from the March 10, 2014 board meeting. Motion passed 4-0.

M/M Hilgendorf/Koth to approve payment of vouchers #2078 through #2146. Motion passed 4-0.

There weren't any license applications.

Our Town Attorney Mark Alberg reported on the request of North Central Conservancy Trust for a refund on their 2013 property taxes. No action was taken.

Byron Lange reported that the road workers will be going to four-ten hour days starting the 1st week of May. Echo Valley Road will not be pulverized or black topped this year. The town will put out proposals for Rapel Road.

There will be a public hearing at 5:15 before the May board meeting to hear comments on the purchase of town property off of High View Road.

M/M Koth/Hilgendorf to accept the proposals from American Asphalt for blacktopping Nibler and Piehl Roads. Motion passed 4-0

M/M Koth/Jelinek to accept the proposal from Lakes Asphalt Maintenance for crack filing of the town roads. Motion passed 4-0

The purchase of a new computer for the cemetery sexton will be placed on the May agenda.

M/M Hilgendorf/Eisenman to approve the conditional use request by Sean DeBels to operate a driving range at the Edgewater Golf Course.

Jelinek reported that the flowers have to be off of the Greenwood Cemetery by April 27th and can be replaced on May 1st. Yard waste containers will be placed at both recycling sites will be from April 26th through June 7th. Both of these announcements have been sent to the Tomahawk Leader.

The board toured the Town of Merrill's Garage area on April 13th; to get ideas for maybe addition's to the Town of Bradley's Hall and Garage areas.

As there was no other business, the meeting was adjourned.
