

Town Board Meeting

January 6, 2020 immediately following the closed meeting at 4:00pm

Bradley Town Hall

Chairman Kevin Koth called the meeting to order at 5:00pm. Supervisors Joan Hilgendorf, Bob Eisenman and Bill Jelinek were present.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund-\$108,619.05 Equipment Fund - \$101,785.31; General Savings Account - \$2,797,230.35; Tax Money Collected - \$2,788,694.89; Checking Account - \$143,462.56; Cemetery Fund - \$100,813.58; Re-Evaluation - \$60,000.00; and Greenwood Cemetery CD - \$12,444.73.

Plan Commission:

Plan Commission Chairman Bethel presented the Board with the their recommendations regarding the Lincoln County ordinance revisions to new boathouse sizes. It was determined that this would be presented to Lincoln County and the Town of Bradley Board will review this again at the February 2020 board meeting.

Employee Wages/Compensation:

Hilgendorf/Jelinek motion to approve the following wage changes- Road Consultant \$19.00/hour; Waste/Recycling \$11.25/hour; Clerk \$25,500/annually; Office help \$8.50/hour; Election chief inspectors \$10.15 and Election officials \$9.65/hour. Employee health benefits will also be listed on the wage schedule. Motion passed 4-0

Town Hall:

Road crew will be putting together a list to remodel the back shop room at the town hall.

Steve Schrammel with the Data People will be doing the monthly updates on the town's computers to keep everything compliant. He will also be ordering the Treasurer a new computer with install date set for February after tax collections.

Waste/Recycling: Hetzel's will be installing the wall mounted heater on January 9th.
