

Town Board Meeting
September 14, 2020 5:30pm

Chairman Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Supervisors Joan Hilgendorf, Bob Eisenman and John Crass were present.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund-\$36,837.75 Equipment Fund - \$27,659.39; General Savings Account - \$213,237.84; Checking Account - \$409,854.39; Cemetery Fund - \$93,611.58; Re-Evaluation - \$60,000.00; and Greenwood Cemetery CD - \$12,468.10.

Plan Commission Chairman Bethel noted there was no August meeting. He was following up with Lincoln County on complaints that were received regarding Airbnb's being ran without the proper permits.

Roads: The two culverts on Schmidtbauer Road had failed and have since been replaced. The Tannery Road project is now complete. The engineer went out and did the final inspection, he stated everything looked great and will be sending in the final certificate next week.

Waste and Recycling: One application has been received so far for the part-time waste/recycling attendant. The Town will accept applications until October 1st.

Cemetery: Cemetery decorations need to be off by September 27th and seasonal decorations may be placed back out starting October 1st.

Parks/Beach Report: Supervisor Crass reported that the ball fields at Theisen Park will receive dirt starting October 5th. Supervisor Eisenman will follow-up with Tom Emmer about doing one last cleaning/mowing at the beach.

Building & Grounds Report: Current town hall cleaner is moving and selling her business. The town will look at other options and may possible go another route.
