#### Access to Our Internet Applications:

### LAND SERVICES - ZONING AND CONSERVATION Phone: 715-539-1087

#### For All Property Owners:

- Zoning Permits: Zoning Permits are required to build, erect, move or relocate any structure onto your property if you are located in the towns of Bradley, Corning, Harding, King, Merrill, Russell, Schley, Scott, Skanawan, Tomahawk, and Wilson **OR** if you are located within the shoreland zone (1,000 feet of a lake, pond or flowage or 300 feet of a river or stream) in an unzoned Town.
- Sanitary Permits: Sanitary permits are required in all Towns. This includes all new or replacement Private Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems (POWTS), Septic or Holding Tank replacement or relocation, reconnections, etc. If you are located within the City of Merrill, City of Tomahawk, or Gleason Sanitary District contact your city or district administration for regulatory information.

#### For Shoreland Property Owners:

- Zoning Permits are required to pave driveways, install patios and retaining walls, or to create other hard surfaces and/or structures on shoreland properties.

#### For Agriculture Property Owners:

- Permits are required prior to beginning the following activities: locate, install, move, reconstruct, extend, enlarge, convert, substantially alter, or change use of an animal waste storage facility and to close an animal waste storage facility.

- Lottery & Gaming Credit: To qualify for this credit you must be the owner of the property **and** this must be your primary residence on 01/01/2017. See your Town Treasurer for more information.
- Dog License: Beginning with the 2019 dog tags, you will no longer be able to purchase them at the Lincoln County Treasurer’s office, located at the Lincoln County Service Center on Sales Street. You will have to purchase them with your Town Treasurer. You can also purchase tags with the Lincoln County Humane Society, if your town has passed a resolution to delegate them as a collecting agent.
