Chairman Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Supervisors Joan Hilgendorf, John Crass and Jennifer Bishop were present.

Public Comment: A letter was submitted to the Town of Bradley board by Joseph Wissing along with a petition submitted by Tom Wolff regarding the proposed Halfmoon Lake Road project.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund-\$53,982.78 Equipment Fund - \$164,149.50; General Savings Account - \$28,304.61; Checking Account - \$551,060.89; Cemetery Fund - \$70,586.58; Re-Evaluation - \$90,000.00; ARPA Fund - \$123,099.40; Capital Outlay - \$20,000.00; and Greenwood Cemetery CD - \$12,515.06.

Hilgendorf/Bishop motion to approve the Modification of Subdivision by H Charles Stahmer LLC to create 2 lots that do not have 30 feet of frontage on a public road. The property is located at N11424 Whispering Pines Road in Section 10, T35N-R6E, in the Town of Bradley. Motion passed 4-0

Road Report:

- Kyes Road is a shared road with the Town of Skanawan. The road was not properly maintained through the summer, so our crew ended up going out and doing some road work to prepare the road for winter plowing. The Town of Skanawan was billed for work completed by the Town of Bradley. The Town of Bradley will need to sit down with the Town of Skanawan to draft and sign a road maintenance agreement.
- At this time the decision was made to not apply for STP Aid as it would require an engineering study that would need to be covered by the town and done prior to the application process.
