Chairman Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Supervisors Joan Hilgendorf, John Crass and Jennifer Bishop were present.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund-\$165,935.99 Equipment Fund - \$212,447.77; General Savings Account - \$3,118,533.36; Checking Account - \$189,379.27; Cemetery Fund - \$70,586.58; Re-Evaluation - \$40,000.00; Capital Outlay - \$17,475.00; and Greenwood Cemetery CD - \$12,688.28; Tax Money Collected - \$3,118,460.56.

Minutes of previous meeting: Monthly meeting held on December 8, 2025-Hilgendorf/Bishop motion to approve. Motion passed 4-0

Clerk's Business:

- A. Payment of vouchers #9955 through #10007- Hilgendorf/Crass motion to approve. Motion passed 4-0
- B. Koth/Crass motion to approve the operator license for Sheena Carew and Claire Albert. Motion passed 4-0

Koth/Crass motion to send the draft ordinance to the DNR for advisory review regarding wake boats. This draft ordinance will cover Lake Nokomis, Rice River Flowage and Bridge Lake. Motion passed 3-1.

It was decided that letters would be sent out to property owners that own short-term rentals within the Town of Bradley to get their opinion on implementing a room tax.

Koth/Hilgendorf motion to approve Sprinter Business to set up the town with .gov emails. At the same time the town will switch from Frontier as the phone and internet provider to Spectrum. Motion passed 4-0

Waste/Recycling: Supervisor Crass spent part of Saturday, January 3rd at the site just making sure the new changes that took effect in the new year ran smoothly. Majority of residents appreciate the changes. Will look at maybe running one day with extended hours so more individuals can get to the site after work.

Road Report:

- The new freightliner will be going in on Wednesday, January 14th for repairs that will be covered under warranty.
- The road crew will continue working with Foley's doing tree limbing on various roads.

Other business not requiring board action: None
