Chairman Kevin Koth called the meeting to order and 5:43pm. Supervisors Joan Hilgendorf, John Crass and Jennifer Bishop were present.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund-\$165,998.42 Equipment Fund - \$212,510.23; General Savings Account - \$210,706.06; Checking Account - \$273,414.55; Capital Outlay - \$17,475.00; Cemetery Fund - \$70,586.58; Re-Evaluation - \$40,000.00; and Greenwood Cemetery CD - \$12,790.94.

Hilgendorf/Crass motion to approve. Motion passed 4-0

Clerk's Business:

- A. Payment of vouchers #10061 through #10165 - Hilgendorf/Bishop motion to approve. Motion passed 4-0
- B. Koth/Hilgendorf motion to approve the operator license for Lydia Shaney, Linda Haig and Jackie Brazeau. Motion passed 4-0

Koth/Bishop motion to approve the public hearing to be held on Saturday, June 6, 2026, at the Tomahawk School District Auditorium at 9:00am regarding the wake boat ordinance in conjunction with the Town of Nokomis. Motion passed 3-1

The Town of Bradley will draft a letter for the Tomahawk Chamber to send out notifying short-term rental owners of the proposed ordinance to enact a room tax in the Town of Bradley.

Koth/Hilgendorf motion to approve the tax payment to property owners on Halfmoon Lake Road. Any amounts under the \$10.00 threshold will not be distributed. Motion passed 4-0

Koth/Bishop motion to approve Resolution 2026-1 supporting the comprehensive and sustainable transportation solution. Motion passed 4-0

Hilgendorf/Koth motion to approve Ordinance 2026-1 appointing an alternate member to the board of review. This ordinance will need to be updated annually. Motion passed 4-0

Crass/Koth motion to approve Ordinance 2026-2 updating the Responsible Unit Recycling Ordinance for the DNR. Motion passed 4-0

Parks/Beach Report: Hilgendorf/Crass motioned to approve Bethel Excavating to do the lawncare maintenance at the parks/beach/town hall for the 2026 season in the amount of \$15,320.00. Motion passed 4-0. Kahle Park school cleaning will be handled by a dedicated cleaner.

Plan Commission: Hilgendorf/Koth motion to approve Resolution 2026-2 regarding data centers. Motion passed 4-0 The next Plan Commission meeting will be held on Monday, April 27th.

Waste/Recycling: Yard waste drop off will again be provided by Tomahawk Iron & Metal from April 27th to May 16th. A lengthy discussion was had regarding disgruntled property owners using the waste/recycling site. Supervisor Crass will put together a card for the waste/recycling employees to hand out so they do not have to deal with the complaints.

Town Hall: Gary Hilgendorf will look at fixing the employee door by the waste/recycling.

Road Report: JJ's Brush Cutting will be doing roadside mowing again for 2026. Loop Road was approved for TRIS funding. Will look at doing this road in 2027 in conjunction with Town of Wilson and Town of Tomahawk. Proposals for 2026 blacktopping have been sent out. This year West Kraft Road, Center Road and Robin Lane (receiving LRIP Funds) are scheduled to be done. Weight Limits are set to come off most roads in the Town of Bradley on April 30th.
