Chairman Kevin Koth called the meeting to order at 5:30pm. Supervisors Joan Hilgendorf, Jennifer Bishop and John Crass were present.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund-\$166,004.61 Equipment Fund - \$212,616.42; General Savings Account - \$10,768.64; Checking Account - \$352,953.22; Capital Outlay - \$17,475.00; Cemetery Fund - \$70,586.58; Re-Evaluation - \$40,000.00; and Greenwood Cemetery CD - \$13,100.50.

The request to create 1 new parcel in a rural residential 1 (RR1) zoning district. The properties are in Section 29, T35N-R6E located along Peaceful Valley Road, in the Town of Bradley. Parcel 's 004-3506-293-9978 and 004-3506-293-9965. Motion passed 4-0. Bishop/Hilgendorf motion to approve the request by Donald and Sharyn Schlising to create a minor subdivision. The request is to create 3 new parcels in a rural residential 1 (RR1) zoning district. The property is in Section 15, T36N-R6E located along Clear Lake Road and Schlising Road, in the Town of Bradley. Parcel #004-3506-151-9937.

Cemetery: Roof has been replaced on the holding house. Foley's will be out removing numerous trees and stumps.

Supervisor Bishop will be getting proposals for the park and town hall maintenance and mowing as well as the cleaning of the port-a-potties for the summer of 2027.

Road Report: Certain roads within the town will be swept this week in preparation for the fall ride. All road construction for 2026 has been completed.
