

# GREENWOOD CEMETERY – Options for Burial

**Traditional:** Single Burial Lots - \$400.00

## Openings and Closings:

- Adult/child: \$600.00
- Infant: \$300.00
- Summer Sunday Burial: \$750.00
- Winter Burial: \$850.00 plus the winter digging rate of \$600.00.
- Winter Sunday Burial: \$850.00 plus the Sunday digging rate of \$750.00.
- Cremation Burial on a single burial lot: \$250.00
- Winter Cremation Burial on a single burial lot: \$500
- Winter storage of caskets for sites other than Greenwood Cemetery: \$500.00 each
- ***Cremains placed in a headstone/monument or scattered on grave site: \$50.00 recording fee. Four cremations or one burial and three cremations will be allowed on one grave site with only one headstone allowed on each grave site.***

## Columbarium:

- Columbarium Niche: \$700.00
- Inurnment, name, and dates (DOB and (DOD) on the door (four styles to choose from) and recorded in cemetery records: \$500.00.
- If name and date of birth (DOB) are engraved on the door pre-need, there will be an additional \$200 to engrave date of death (DOD) at the time of need (will be billed directly to the customer by Tomahawk Monument Company).

## Scattering Garden:

- Includes scattering of ashes, name on plaque, and recorded in cemetery records: \$475.00.

## Veterans section – spousal burials:

A Spouse can be buried in the Veteran portion of the cemetery one of three ways:

- Two cremains (one the Veteran and one the spouse)
- One cremains and one casket (one the Veteran and one the spouse)
- Two caskets – one of top of the other

One gravesite only, one headstone only.

If it is a spousal burial, the family pays for the opening and closing of grave.

***Per Wisconsin Statutes 157.111 If a grave, mausoleum space, or other place used or intended to be used for the burial of human remains is located in a cemetery owned or operated by a cemetery authority, only the cemetery authority or a person designated by the cemetery authority may open or close the grave, mausoleum space or other place used or intended to be used for the burial of human remains.***

***157.113 - Permission to place cremated human remains in a cemetery. No person may deposit any cremated human remains in a cemetery, including in the casket of another person, without the permission of the cemetery authority.***
