Greenwood Cemetery Regulations

The speed limit in the cemetery is 10 mph for any motorized vehicle.

No recreational motorized vehicles are allowed.

No person may loiter or engage in sports or other recreational activities.

All firearms are prohibited in the cemetery except when used at military funerals or memorial events. Hunting, trapping, and shooting are prohibited.

No person may litter, dump, or deposit any rubbish, refuse, earth, or other material on cemetery property.

Any urns, decorations, memorabilia, or personal items placed on a grave must be on the side of the stone. Those items causing maintenance problems will be removed.

Shepherd hooks and solar lights may be placed on the side of stone.

No watering of an area for more than one hour daily is permitted.

Approval must be obtained from the sexton before planting any trees or shrubs.

The Bradley Town officials, employees, contractors, agents, or the sexton shall not be responsible for the protection or maintenance of flowers, wreaths, plants, urns, or any personal items placed on graves.

Seasonal Decorations

Artificial flowers, potted plants, all decorations, containers, removable urns, and flags may be placed on the sides of stones or monuments after May 1st of each year and must be removed by the 3rd (third) Saturday in September of each year.

Seasonal decorations may again be placed on the sides of stones after October 1st of each year and must be removed by the 2nd (second) Saturday in April of each year.

Any item placed on a lot that violates the rules as described above may be removed.
